

SAFE CHEMICAL HANDLING GUIDE

Never "top up" - It is dangerous & can lead to cross contamination

Never mix chemicals - It is dangerous & counter productive

More is not better - Dangerous, Harsh, Takes longer to remove, Not economical

Less is not better - Won't clean, Leads to soil build up

Never bring your own chemicals into the workplace

Reptd Reflection Stooms

STORAGE:

- Storage rooms should be kept clean, tidy & locked
- · Always store powders above liquid
- Never stack drums more than 3 high
- · Never dispense chemicals above your eyes
- Separate chlorine products from oxyidizing agents
- Rooms should be provided with adequate ventilation
- Safety Data Sheets (SDS) should be stored where chemicals are kept & Wall Charts should be displayed

BEWARE OF PRODUCTS BEARING THESE SYMBOLS. READ SDS BEFORE USING ANY PRODUCT.



















LABELS:

- All chemical containers should have labels
- · Labels should be legible and not damaged
- Replacement labels should be available at all times

CHEMICAL SPILL KITS

FIRST AID KITS:

Should be available and easily accessible

PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (P.P.E.)

- P.P.E. Should always be worn when handling and dispensing chemicals including empty containers
- P.P.E. Should be kept in a clean labelled container
- P.P.E. Should be in clean and in good working order
- P.P.E. Should be replaced when damaged or dirty

ENSURE THAT PERSONAL PROTECTIVE CLOTHING (P.P.E.) IS ALWAYS WORN WHEN HANDLING CHEMICALS

OVERALL:

All staff should take care & use common sense when handling chemicals. If you are unsure as to the correct use, handling, first aid instructions or what chemical you should be using, contact your supervisor or your representitive from RapidClean.

SAFE CHEMICAL HANDLING

PROCEDURE:

- Firstly READ THE LABEL.
- Be familiar with FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS.
- DO NOT mix chemicals.
- Dilute ONLY as directed.
- DO NOT de-cant unless directed.
- Use correct EQUIPMENT to assist in cleaning process scourer pads, deck scrubbers, griddle system, etc.
- AVOID contact with skin and eyes.
- AVOID breathing vapours of Oven & Hot Plate Cleaner. Wear face mask.
- WEAR prescribed protective clothing.
- WEAR gloves and protective eyewear when handling products.
- DO NOT dispense chemicals above eye level.
